# WEEKLY RECAP FOR OUR CAMP PROGRAMS



It was a howling week of fun here at ESF, filled with thrills, chills and masquerade madness! Day campers' science experiments popped, fizzed and bubbled in Project Discovery this week. Wednesday was both spooky and wacky as campers came dressed in a Halloween costume to camp! This week was filled up ghostly scavengers and trick or treating. To close this awesome week, Day Campers enjoyed popsicles during their Dance Party and Pow Wow on Friday.



The Adventurers, Voyagers, Pathfinders and Mountaineers were so excited to start Week 7 and came in ready for their new True Life Adventure theme of the week. TLA this week was Elements of Filmmaking: Broadcast Media. Campers wrote scripts, created characters, selected costumes, filmed, added effects and edited. A special guest, Zia, arrived on Wednesday to perform for Senior Camp. On Thursday, Senior campers jumped into the pool for The Great Boat Regatta. They built boats out of recycled materials and set sail! To celebrate the premiere of their new films, Senior campers had a Film Festival to close the week!



Mess Fest: Radical Reactions and Extreme Experiments, Space & Rocketry and Jr. Art Studio were very busy with their specialized activities! In Mess Fest, campers learned about oil spills and saw how they are cleaned up. They also performed chemical reactions, squid dissections, explosions and watermelon implosions. Meanwhile in Space and Rocketry, campers learned about angles, aerodynamics and all things rocketry. Campers also built and presented bottle rockets and fuel rockets that can go as high as 400 feet. In Jr. Art Studio, campers made papier mache masks, paintings on canvas and stained glass masterpieces. They also drew sketches and painted a picture from an ant's perspective.



Sports campers had an action-packed week! They participated in skills, games and activities in preparation for their weekly Tournament Day at the end of the week. Sports this week included frisbee, soccer, lacrosse, basketball, handball and flag football. On Wednesday, special guests Rick Jacobs visited camp to discuss important character values and how to incorporate them into playing sports. For Tournament Day on Friday, campers came dressed in their favorite soccer team's gear and colors for World Cup Day.



Campers in Junior Robotics; Level 1, Minecraft Missions 2017 and Junior LEGO Master Builders: Star Wars Adventures were back in the tech world for week 7! In Jr. Robotics, campers followed special steps to build a robotic object of their choice. Once their object was built they programed it on the computer to bring it to life! By the end of the week, they began creating their own objects and their own code without steps. Over in Minecraft Missions, campers learned basic design principals and together made a group server to build their own virtual city. While in Junior LEGO, campers built rebel starships and bases from engineering and Star Wars kits. By using LEGOS, campers were able to see just how machines work.



Tennis Camp jumped back into the action for Week 7! Throughout the week, campers assessed and practiced their skills through relays, stations and drills. This week they also focused on footwork drills and maintaining consistency when hitting. In addition, Tennis campers practiced focus drills before their competitions and tournaments at the end of the week began. Tennis games like "Jail," "Defender" and "Bobsled" were played to focus on practicing ground strokes, serves, footwork, consistency and volleys.
